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Process

First contact between students	
Topic/lesson	Broadening the knowledge of each other- a week of teenager's life
Aim	Getting to know each other
Timing	March– 3 lessons – 3 weeks
Materials/links/resources needed	Pictures, facebook, skype, email
Steps-by-step methodology (concrete tasks, exercises)	Presentation with picture and text – typewritten and sent by email Write a description of your week , write clarifying questions Exchange of presentation and of questions – answers
Offline teaching	
Topic/lesson	Give students a plan of their composition-school time, free time, meeting friends and celebrations
Aim	To introduce students to the topic of poverty
Timing	March, April– 2 lessons – 2 weeks
Materials/links/reources needed	MDG 1 materials, inviting someone from Third world network, or Frank.
Steps-by-step methodology (concrete tasks, exercises)	Design of the teacher's notes on the topic Include questions to the students about poverty and their personal observations and experiences. Final draft of the teacher's notes on the topic that includes as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. An overview of what poverty is and what causes it 2. Make the connection between individual and the issue of poverty. 3. Manifestation of poverty and possible solutions. Explain now about the research that they will have to do on their own. Encourage them to be as creative as possible. Divide the students into 4 (5) groups now.
Individual / group work (student „research“)	





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Topic/lesson	A closer look
Aim	To make students become aware of the problems toward their own research
Timing	April– 2 lessons – 2 weeks, plus homework and after classes work in library for the poster activity April – 1 lesson for the interviews with parents/elderly
Materials/links/reources needed	Internet, Newspapers, Magazines to be cut, Pictures, Text created together with their parents. Pictures of the posters to be shared online
Steps-by-step methodology (concrete tasks, exercises)	<p>Divide the club in 4 (5) groups 2 manifestation of poverty and 2 solutions.</p> <p>Poster activity Assign each of the four groups to do research on all of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Why is the situation like this? 2. How did it happen? 3. What steps to take to minimize the effect of poverty in order to solve the problem – to include students' recommendations. 4. To find articles in the newspapers, and online newspapers to represent the problem on a local and global levels. 5. May be one small students group to do a research on Fair Trade. <p>Output a typewritten text of one to two pages for each group. Make each of the groups present. Combine the groups. Make them work on: 1 poster on poverty manifestation and 1 poster on how to solve the problem that represent their research and their findings. Make the posters and take pictures of each one of the two posters to be shared with the partner school.</p> <p>Interview activity Individual work: Everybody together - to prepare the questionnaire that will be used with the elderly – parents, family members. Individually - to collect personal story on personal experience about poverty - from a parent/elderly – output – 1 to 2 pages typewritten personal story to share them.</p>

Topic/lesson	Walking the path
Aim	To learn about the others' perceptions about and problems (include cultural topic.)
Timing	May – 1 lesson of 80 minutes – 1 week
Materials/links/reources needed	Facebook page, email
Steps-by-step methodology (concrete tasks, exercises)	Take pictures of the two posters and share them on facebook. Send the typewritten the interviews by email between the two teachers. Once looking at the shared work, students and teachers prepare and e-mail questions about the work of the other group.

Topic/lesson	Poverty and the teenagers
Aim	To accelerate their awareness on the topic.
Timing	May – 1 lesson of 80 minutes – 1 week
Materials/links/reources needed	Skype
Steps-by-step methodology (concrete tasks, exercises)	Share your skype addresses Prepare your moderation and students questions Fix the time Connect to skype If does not work with Internet – please email to the other teacher. Go with students questions, enhance students to talk. Moderate. (Also, keep in mind it will be interesting for the students from both groups if they give recent information about the political situation, or anything currently happening in their country,etc.)

Topic/lesson	Our contribution
Aim	To involve the community, put into action what they have learned.
Timing	Up to 1 lesson of 80 min.
Materials/links/reources needed	Cameras to document the action, please, document. Printer to print leaflets or adds. Donate everything you don't use –clothes,toys,books, your work-postcards, cookies, food, fruit etc. and organise a sale to collect money. The slogan will be HELP
Steps-by-step methodology (concrete tasks, exercises)	Discuss with the students what they want to do to contribute to the solving of the problem. Give them time to plan their action. Guide them, but let them be creative. Plan simple things. Implement. Keep it open (possible – hand in flyers that students prepare, make a presentation to their peers, make adds on the school board etc.) Document – pictures, video of the action. Typewritten material, if any.

Topic/lesson	We need your support.
Aim	To receive feedback from parents.
Timing	June– 1 lesson of 80 minutes – 1 week
Materials/links/reources needed	The written text from students from their previous work done on the topic. To create a letter from the student to their parents and print it.
Steps-by-step methodology (concrete tasks, exercises)	A letter to parents made by students on their work. To invite parents in school to see the posters and to see their children's personal achievement and gaining of knowledge. To elicit parents to help and contribute to both school and students in need.

Steps-by-step methodology (concrete tasks, exercises)	Prepare a summary of what happened and questions to the students – what did they learned and what went well, what they could do better.
